English-

As some of you may remember from last year, it's really hard to explain some of our English lessons without a recorded video. Instead, I've added lots of SP&G activity mats, which are attached resources, that are ideal to keep our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills up. Try one of them related to your year group.

Maths –In class, we'll be looking at representing numbers on a number line. Year 2 children work between 0-100 and Year 3 children work between 0-1000.

I'm going to give the children in class a large piece of sugar paper and get them to draw a long line which will act as the blank number line. I'll then get them to put 0 at one end and either 100 or 1000 at the other end. I'll then give children numbers (within their parameters) and ask them to estimate where they think they'll be on the number line. Try this at home.
