Collective Worships are held daily in school, providing an opportunity for the children to come together. Weekly themes are set for these special times.

Fortnightly Parents' Sharing Assemblies are held in the school hall at 2.45pm on Fridays. This is an opportunity for the children to come together and share topics they have been working on during the week. Each class will contribute and all the children take part on a regular basis. The children have the opportunity to play music together and, where appropriate, individually. During the Sharing Assembly each class teacher will nominate children who have made a specific contribution to the class or made particular progress for a reward certificate and sticker awarded by the Headteacher.
