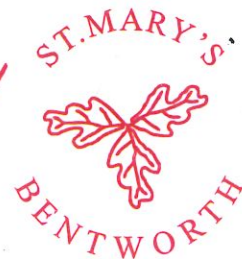

Professional Promise

- **Punctuality**
Arrive on time, in line with contracted hours, organised and ready to begin working day. Extends to attendance of staff and other school related meetings.
- **Professional development**
Show a proactive approach and commitment to continuing professional development appropriate to my role.
- **Professional appearance**
Take pride in smart, professional dress appropriate to school duties.
- **Stakeholder relationships**
Maintain positive and professional relationships with all stake holders allowing good working relationships to achieve shared goals.
- **Behaviour/conduct inside school**
Behave professionally, respectfully and in a manner that is supportive to all, modelling school and Christian values.
- **Safety**
Observe, and stay up to date with, school's health and safety and safeguarding practices and procedures. Ensure safety of all children at all times.
- **Behaviour/conduct outside school**
Staff are representatives of the school on and off site. Maintain high standards of ethics and behaviour within and outside school in line with Teachers' Standards.
- **Attitude**
Demonstrate a positive, encouraging outlook and approach. Be a team player.
- **Relationship with children**
Develop professional, supportive and mutually respectful relationships establishing clear and appropriate working boundaries.
- **Confidentiality**
Observe strict confidentiality at all times in line with school policy.
- **Safeguarding responsibilities**
Provide a safe learning environment at all times.
Have up to date knowledge of all safeguarding policies and procedures. Clearly understand procedure for contacting school's Child Protection Liaison Officer (CPLO) and report concerns immediately.
- **High standards**
Demonstrate and promote high standards of professionalism, learning and behaviour. Strive to reflect and evaluate one's practice to better support the needs of learners.
- **Christian values**
Uphold, foster and support the Christian values of the school.
- **Social media**
Observe school's social media and e-safety policies. Will not reference school, pupils or staff, or upload photographs of same, onto social media sites.
Frequently check security settings.
- **British values**
Respect fundamental British Values and cultural diversity.
- **Accountability**
Take ownership of areas of responsibility, be able to provide evidence and take part in professional discussion about progress.
Hold school to account to ensure the needs of all learners are met.
- **Policies, practices and procedures**
Have a working knowledge of all school policies. Stay informed of policy updates via staff meetings, governing body minutes and policy file.
